This is the site of what has been described as Washington's biggest single highway construction project of all time. It involves the E Street Expressway, the Inner Loop, K Street remodeling, Potomac River Freeway and Theodore Roosevelt Bridge ramps. The new State Department Building is at left center and the structure with the curving

facade on Virginia Avenue, which runs across the photo diagonally, is the Pan American Health Organization Building. At the top of the photo are, from left, Theodore Roosevelt Island, Key Bridge, the Whitehurst Freeway and Georgetown. Some George Washington University buildings appear at right center.
